AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF QUINTON TO
ENACT GUIDELINES FOR THE ORDERLY RECORDING OF OPEN PUBLIC TOWNSHIP
MEETINGS

The purpose of this Ordinance Members of the general public have the right to videotape portions or all of an open public meeting of the governing body, except at closed or executive session discussions. These guidelines are intended to ensure that the right of the public to videotape and record official public meetings does not interfere with the business of the governing body or other citizens' right of access to the proceedings.

NOTICE

This Ordinance was introduced by not less than a majority vote of the members of the governing body on March 3, 2026. It is further certified that after posting and publication according to law, a public hearing and subsequent adoption of said Ordinance will be held on April 7, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. in the Quinton Township Municipal Building, at which time anyone interested in commenting on this Ordinance will be heard.
