The clerk gave the committee draft copies of the Employee Manual and Policy and Procedure Manual to look over for approval at the October meeting.

The clerk gave the Lock Out/ Tag Out and Worker Protection Manuals to the committee for review.

The Revised In Rem list of property for sale was given to the committee and they decided on a date of October 18, 2023 at 6:00pm.

Mayor Sperry asked the clerk to contact the Solicitor about the crossing guard issue.

The clerk informed the committee about the asbestos in the basement and planning board building and the problem will be taken care of as soon as possible.

Mayor Sperry shared the updated regulations for the Stormwater Tier A permit we are now part of and will send a copy to the clerk and other committee members. The Mayor also reported that the sewer pumps are up and running. The Salem Sewer Operator wants to use the old pump from Grieves Parkway to put in the Quinton Alloway Road Pump station since it was just rebuilt and that pump station needs it. They also want to replace water meters for the pump stations to help with the billing issues.
