AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF QUINTON, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 170, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 170-63(E), ENTITLED "PUBLIC NOTICE OF A HEARING," TO REVISE PUBLIC NOTICE REQUIREMENTS AND TO INCORPORATE THE PUBLIC NOTICE LAW 2025

**PURPOSE AND FINDINGS**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Quinton seeks to update and clarify the public notice procedures applicable to development applications heard by the Planning Board, to ensure transparency, consistency, and due process; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 170, Article VII, Section 170-63 of the Township Code sets forth provisions applicable to the Planning Board, including public notice requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has reviewed the existing language of Section 170-63(E) and determined that amendments are necessary to conform local procedures to the Public Notice law 2025 and to provide clear, uniform standards for service and delivery of notice to individuals, corporations, and other non-public entities, including timing and acceptable methods of service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee finds that these amendments will promote effective public participation and fair notice to affected persons and entities in connection with Planning Board hearings;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Quinton, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 170, Article VII, Section 170-63(E) of the Code of the Township of Quinton is hereby amended as follows:

**Section 1.** Amendment to Section 170-63(E) (Public notice of a hearing)

A. Section 170-63(E) is hereby amended to add the following Section 2.1:

(2.1) Notice to Municipal Clerk for Website Posting. In addition to the notice required by Subsection (E)(2), any non-public entity or individual applicant shall, at least 12 days prior to the date of the hearing, serve a copy of the public notice on the Municipal Clerk for posting on the Township's official website. Service on the Municipal Clerk may be made by personal delivery, by certified mail, or by email to [clerk@quintonnj.com](mailto:clerk@quintonnj.com) and notice shall be deemed complete upon delivery, mailing or emailing. Website posting by the Township shall not relieve the applicant of any other notice obligations set forth in this section.

**Section 3. Repealer; Conflict**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

**Section 4. Severability**
